More Information & Change of Date

We just became aware of other local events that are happening on original date of 13 July, these are the Penngrove Power and Implement Museum and Sebastopol VFW Car Show, both only happen once a year. To allow members to attend these other functions and still participate in the Cooker Tour, the Cooker Tour date has been changed from 13 July (Saturday) to 14 July (Sunday).

The following refresher items are provided for the Cooker Tour on 14 July

- 1. The Washoe House on Stony Point Road is the meeting place. Arrive 09:30 Depart 10:00
- **2.** The end point is Ragle Ranch Regional Park in Sebastopol, this is a Sonoma County Park and the Parking fee is \$7 if you do not have a Sonoma County Park pass with you.
