# Notice of Proposed Change to REMTC Bylaws

To be addressed at the June 1<sup>st</sup> membership meeting at Round Table Pizza, Marlow Rd, Santa Rosa at 7:00 pm.

Background: As REMTC evolves, more of our members live away from Sonoma County and some members prefer not to drive at night so that we often do not have a quorum as defined in our Bylaws (two Board members and twenty-five percent of the membership). In the meeting of the Board and the Chairpersons at the beginning of the year, a change to the Bylaws was discussed and subsequently a draft change was developed. After that was done, two REMTC members independently pointed out another possible problem. Frequently, a husband and wife both serve on the Board. This means that a quorum could be constituted with a husband and wife, possibly having similar views, so that they would have undue influence on the business of REMTC. Both of the REMTC members suggested that a quorum should have three Board members and this suggestion was incorporated in the proposed change.

Current Bylaw: Article IV, Section 6: A quorum shall be constituted if two current board members and twenty-five percent (25%) of all voting members are present at a meeting. If a quorum is not present at the meeting, a binding vote may not be taken; Board of directors may pass a resolution to act upon policy matters by a simple majority vote.

Propose Bylaw: Article IV, Section 6: A quorum shall consist of three current board members and members in good standing present at a general meeting. If a quorum is not present at a meeting, a binding vote may not be taken. Board of directors may pass a resolution to act upon policy matters by a simple majority vote.

Not present were Steve DePaoli and Bob Salomon.


There were a 127 cars present and lots of people. It was a fun day.
