Bella Rosa Coffee Tour

On Sept. 6th, the REMTC was invited to tour the Bella Rosa Coffee Company, with Bella Rosa co-owner Dominic Cerniglio giving the tour. Nine Model T's showed up for the visit, and Dominic was very excited to show us how the company operates and what distinguishes his coffee from others. Bella Rosa is a certified organic coffee company, plus they use a unique hot air method of roasting the beans that is very uniform and does not create the acid that can effect some coffee drinkers digestive systems.

Dominic is a very dedicated and passionate person, and it shows in his description of how he came to be a co-owner in the company, as well as how carefully they monitor the entire roasting and distribution process. Being an organic coffee company, they are subject to random inspections and reviews to make certain they are in compliance with all the regulations that certify them organic. To achieve this, Bella Rosa maintains and extensive database of each coffee batch as it gets processed through the line, and it is completely traceable from the origin of the beans to the final customer that receives the finished product lot-by-lot. Dominic wears many hats in the company from dealing with coffee brokers to fixing coffee machines that are loaned out to various companies for events and sample tastings. At the same time, he's a down to earth kind of person that thoroughly enjoyed our Model T's and even invited us to bring one of them inside the warehouse for pictures. Fittingly, Donna Jones' gorgeous pickup was chosen to come inside for a photo-op.

After the tour was concluded, Jeannine & Andy led the group on a delightful backroad tour clear up near Healdsburg, and then backtracked to Shiloh Regional Park where we sat down in the gazebo to eat our carry-on lunches. Many thanks to Jeannine for arranging this tour as well as the nice drive for lunch.
